The Compassionate Friends Victoria (TCFV) is dedicated to supporting grieving parents, siblings and grandparents in the event of the death of a child – of any age or from any cause.

TCF understand the indescribable pain caused by this loss, because their support team members have each experienced the loss of a child, sibling or grandchild.

They use their lived experience to provide peer support for grieving family members. This means that whenever you speak to a member of TCFV's volunteer support team, you will be speaking to a person who has common experiences to you and who can provide a range of support services and activities to help you cope with your grief.

BEREAVED PARENT, SIBLING & GRANDPARENT SUPPORT CENTRE – located in Canterbury, in Melbourne's eastern suburbs, where you can meet other people in a similar situation.

HELPLINE, 24 HOURS, 365 DAYS – grief-support phone line provided by members who have been trained as peer-support volunteers.

SUPPORT AND SOCIAL GROUPS – run by bereaved parents siblings, and grandparents, who have been trained as peer supporters, at various locations around Melbourne and regional Victoria.

TIME-OUT PROGRAM – A range of accommodation options to provide members needing a 'time out' from the grief and stress of everyday living after suffering the loss of a loved one at a low cost.
