



GPV/KCV SUPPORTS THE RIGHT OF CHILDREN AND ADULTS TO KNOW THEIR BIOLOGICAL IDENTITY

GPV/KCV believes that it is the right of every child to know their biological identity and that:

- 1. Siblings have the right to be placed together
- 2. Children over 12 years have the right to participate in decisions about their life
- 3. A child's given name, as it is registered on the original birth certificate/s, must be maintained
- 4. Children who are removed from their country of birth must be provided with a cultural program designed to maintain their cultural identity.
- 5. Legislation must provide for contact between the adopted child and the extended biological family to be maintained after an adoption
- 6. The child has the right to claim inheritance rights from the family of birth
- 7. An adopted child's biological identity should be reflected on their birth certificate/s and other legal documentation and that:
 - the woman who carries the child must be listed as the mother, except where the woman has no biological connection with the child.
 - The man whose sperm created the child be listed as the 'sperm donor'
 - the woman whose DNA created the child be listed as the 'egg donor'
