



FREE TRAVEL FOR YOUNG VICTORIANS FROM JANUARY 2026



From 1 January 2026, public transport will be free for children under 18, saving families up to \$755 per child, per year.

From Thursday 1 January 2026, people aged under 18 can travel free on all Victorian public transport services. This includes trams, trains, buses and coach services anytime and to anywhere.

TO ACCESS FREE TRAVEL

From January, young people must use a new youth myki card and tap the card on and off each time they travel. A youth myki card will be available for \$5. Once purchased, Youth myki will unlock free travel on trains, trams and buses in Victoria.

For areas that do not use myki cards, they must show their myki card to travel free.
