CARE ALLOWANCE

Direct carer payment: Contributes to day-to-day costs incurred while providing home-based care. Five care allowance levels available based on assessment of child's needs and ongoing specialist or support costs.

SCHOOL ATTENDANCE ALLOWANCE

School Attendance Allowance - Quarterly payment, paid in arrears to eligible carers of children between the ages of 5 and 18 years to contribute to meeting the educational costs.

HOME STRETCH HOME-BASED CARER ALLOWANCE

Direct carer payment: Contributes to the day-to-day costs incurred caring for a young person aged 18 yrs-21 years (i.e. accommodation, utilities, telephone and internet).

CLIENT EXPENSES

Support to purchase: items/services that exceed the day-to-day costs of the care allowance contribution, including costs to facilitate access between children and their families.

KINSHIP CARE PLACEMENT SUPPORT

Support to purchase: Time-limited or one-off supports required to establish or stabilise kinship care placements.

Support to purchase: Flexible funding to meet the extraordinary needs of children transitioning to a permanent care order or on a permanent care order.

Provision of non-branded school clothing and footwear free of charge, or subsidised branded uniforms. Also provides free or subsidise materials, learning devices, educational resource and 30-day travel passes.

CAMP, SPORTS AND EDUCATION FUND

Contributes to cost of school trips, camps, incursions, outdoor education programs, sporting activities and graduations for children attending a gov or non-gov Victorian primary or secondary school.
