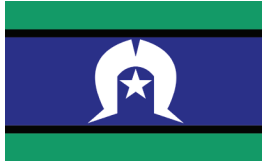

EARLY START KINDER (ESK) FOR CHILDREN WITH CHILD PROTECTION

Program for all children who have had contact with Child Protection and are aged three years by April 30 in the year they will be attending are eligible for Early Start Kindergarten. ESK provides children with 15 hrs of FREE kindergarten.

HOME STRETCH HOME-BASED CARER ALLOWANCE

Direct carer payment: Contributes to the day-to-day costs incurred caring for a young person aged 18 yrs-21 years (i.e. accommodation, utilities, telephone and internet).

CLIENT EXPENSES/CLIENT SUPPORT FUNDING

Support to purchase: items/services that exceed the day-to-day costs of the care allowance contribution, including costs to facilitate access between children and their families.

KINSHIP CARERS WELCOME PACK

CARE SUPPORT HELP DESK

Provides support to foster and statutory kinship carers. Initiates applying for critical documents for children in care (Medicare, Birth Certificate) and provides carers with letters to access Centrelink supports.

CARE ALLOWANCE

Direct carer payment: Contributes to day-to-day costs incurred while providing home-based care. Five care allowance levels available based on assessment of child's needs and ongoing specialist or support costs.

VICTORIAN MANAGED INSURANCE AUTHORITY

Provision of insurance to the property of volunteer caregivers, in the event it is damaged by people in their care.
