Free Travel for Young People Under 18

From 1 January 2026, all Victorians under 18 are entitled to free public transport with the new Youth Myki card.

- Children 4 and under travel free without a myki, youth aged 5-17 travel free with a Youth miki
- Applies across all public transport in Victoria
- A Youth myki card is available for \$5 at staffed stations or online

Victorian Carer Card holder discounts

Victorian Carer Card holders can get:

- concession fares using a carer myki
- free weekend travel
- free travel during National Carers week (held in October)
- free weekend travel, statewide
- 2 (metro residents) or 4 (regional residents) free off-peak travel vouchers every year

Concessions for Students

Eligible Victorian students can get a myki concession card with a student pass. It gives them fifty per cent off public transport fares.

To apply for a student pass, students must:

- Have an eligible student ID
- Complete the Transport Victoria School Student ID and Student Pass application
- Take the application to a staffed station

Eligible tertiary students can apply for myki concession card by applying for a Transport Victoria Tertiary Student ID.

Free Travel Vouchers for Concession Card Holders

Eligible Victorian concession card holders receive an annual allocation of paperless free travel vouchers after completing a one-time registration.

To access free travel vouchers annually, you must live in Victoria and hold a:

- Pensioner Concession Card (PCC) (all codes)
- Department of Veterans' Affairs (DVA) PCC
- Victorian Seniors Card
- Victorian Carer Card ('We Care' Card).

Reduced Vehicle Registration Costs

Eligible Health Care Card, Pensioner and DVA Card holders can receive a discount on vehicle registration.

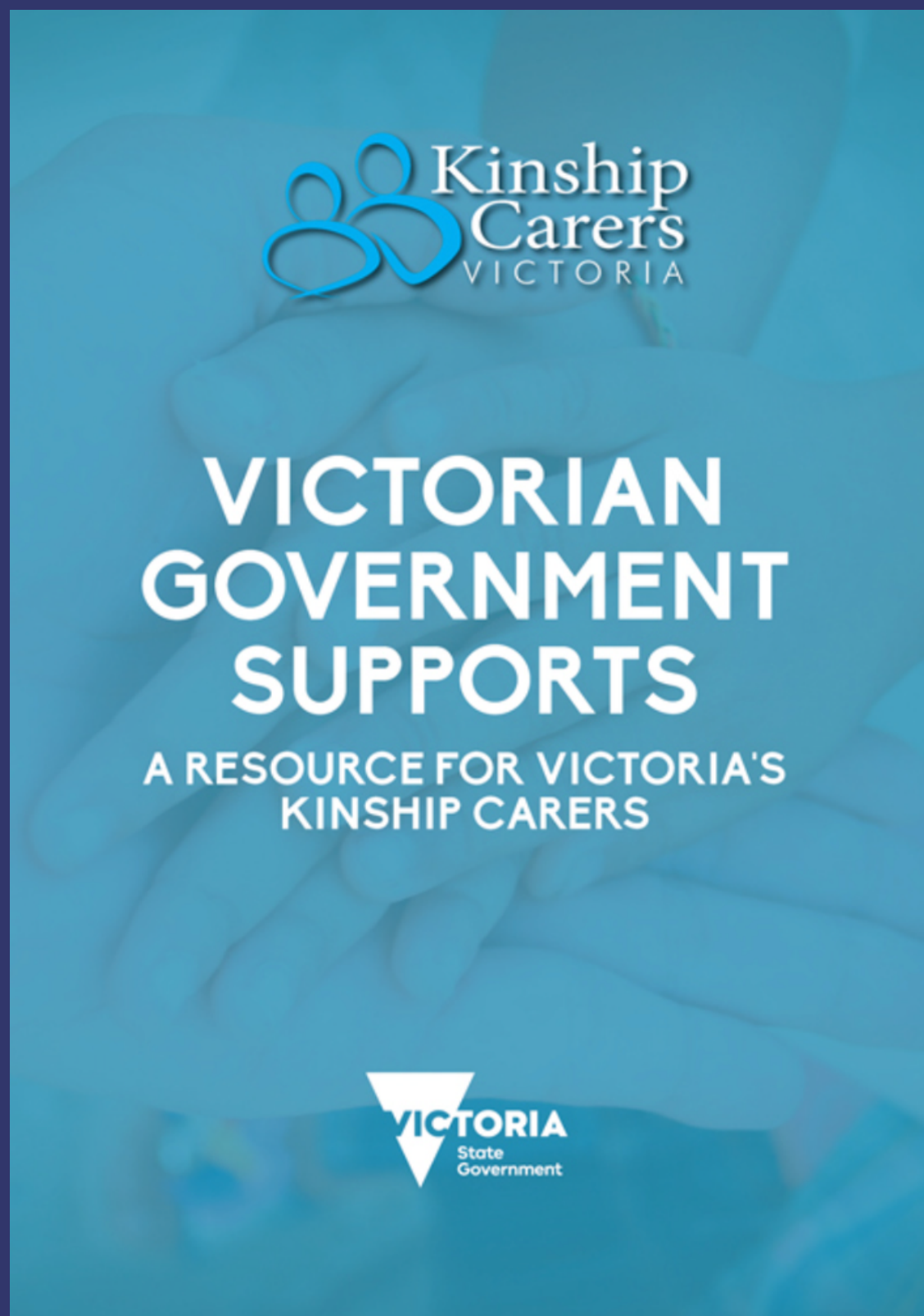
- Apply for registration concession using your myVicRoads account
- This concession provides a 50 per cent reduction on the motor vehicle registration fee component of your registration bill (not the TAC charge)
- Free registration is also available for vehicles used to transport wheelchair users.
